- **Values (V):** Values and beliefs of the profession: codified in the Code of Ethics
- **Skills (S):** Demonstrated ability to practice social work interventions (that integrate values, knowledge, and cognitive and affective processes).
- **Cognitive and Affective Processes (C & AP):** As defined in CSWE 2015 EPAS Glossary - (includes critical thinking, affective reactions, and exercise of judgment)
 - *Critical Thinking:* an intellectual, disciplined process of conceptualizing, analyzing, evaluating and synthesizing multiple sources of information generated by observation, reflection and reasoning.
 - *Affective Reactions:* the way in which our emotions influence our thinking and subsequent behavior.
 - *Judgement:* the capacity to perceive and discern multiple sources to form an opinion.
